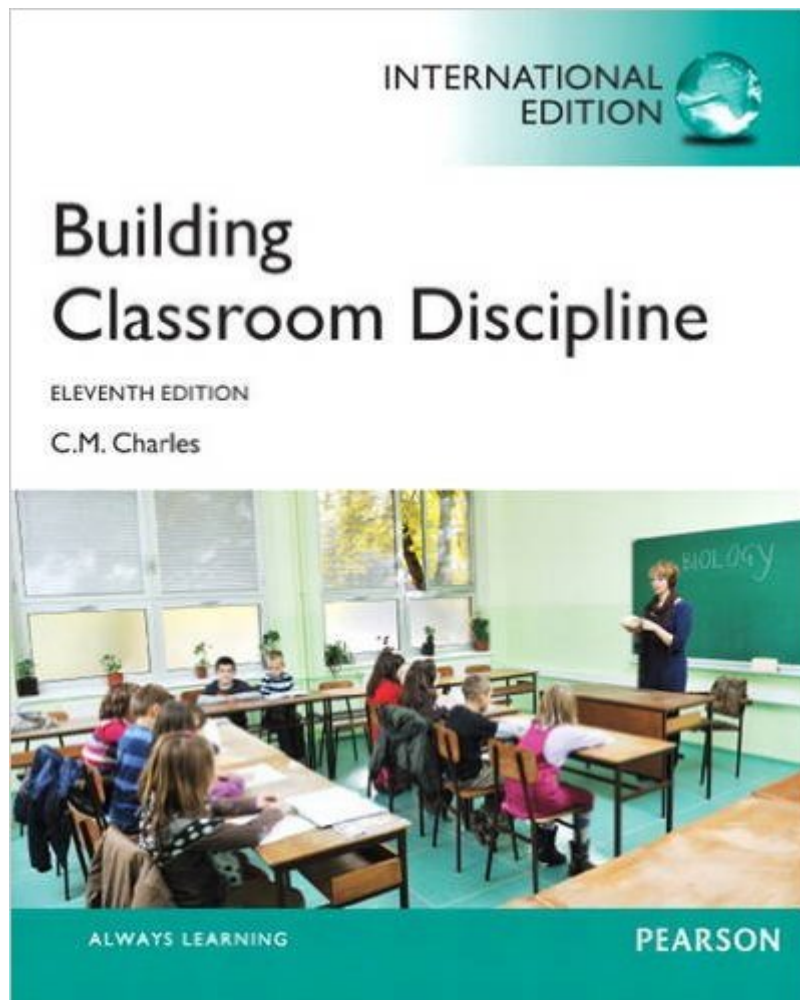

There are very informative examples of how to implement discipline in the classroom in a way which builds self-discipline through structured routines.

To make it work I had to install Google chrome and install the Kindle for PC (Windows 7 version) app to my windows 8 desktop, and open it there. Kind of disappointing, but still functional.
