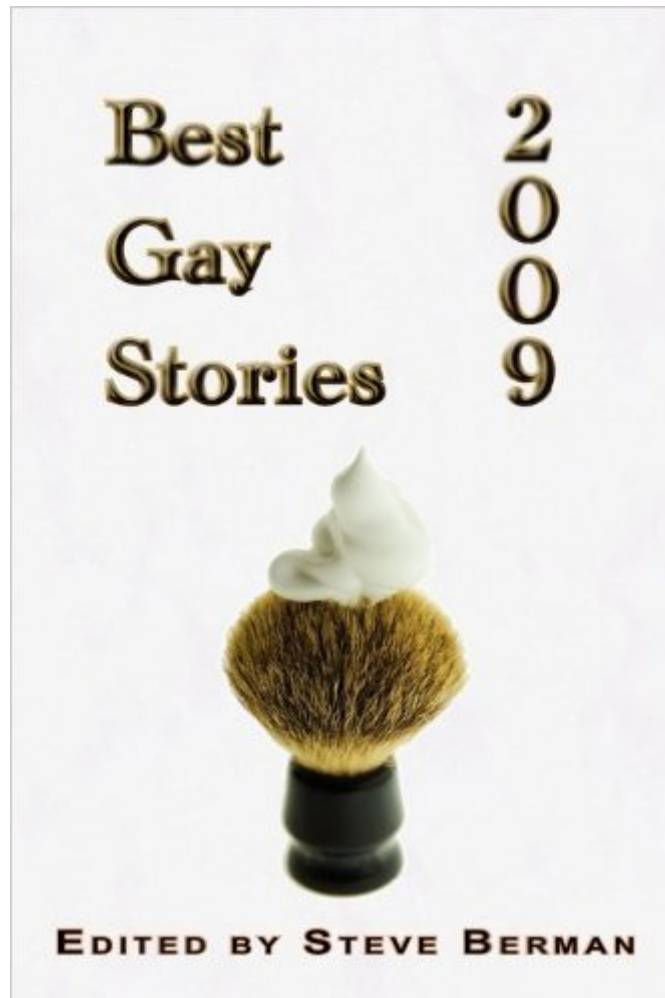


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# Best Gay Stories 2009

Should gay stories be judged with the same criteria as straight stories? Of course. Is there such as thing as gay or straight stories? A more difficult question. As a writer, I chose this book to get an idea of what constituted a "best" gay story. The particular taste of the editor is certainly a factor and his take on literary (or fictional) excellence. I had an agenda: I want my gay characters in a novel I am writing to be three dimensional and not cliches. The examples in this collection vary from the banal to the sublime--not unusual in any collection of short stories by different authors, gay or straight. I accomplished my goal, enjoyed many of the stories, learned from them about gay life and just plain life. I won't mention my favorites, since every reader will have his own interests and taste, but the collection in general--if uneven--is an interesting read.

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
