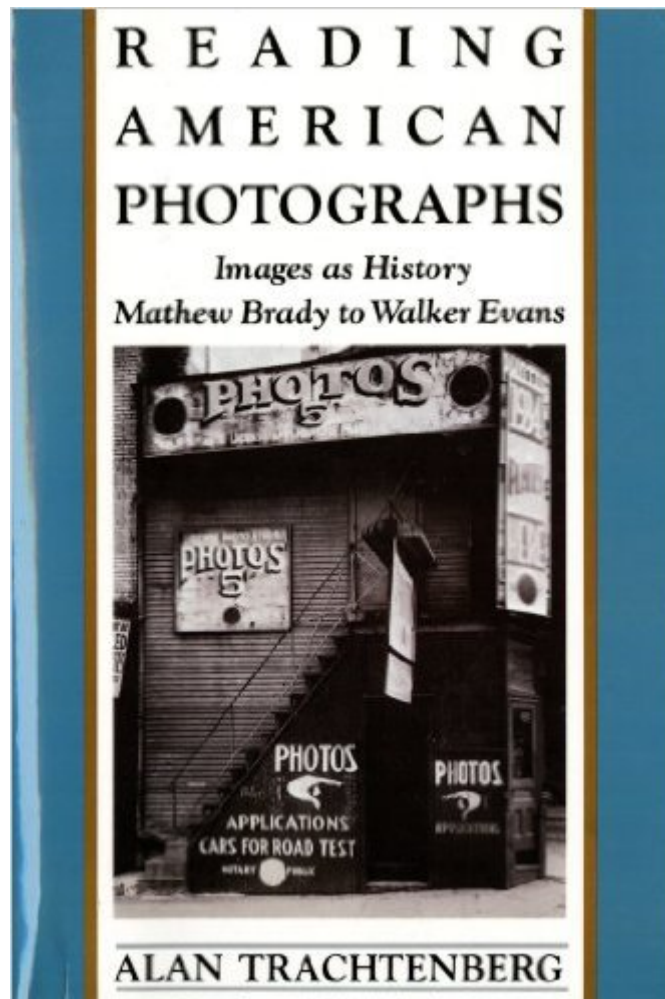

This well-written and constructed book covers much more than from Mathew Brady to Walker Evans, it also broaches photography subjects that were previously found in the realms of art history, architectural photographs, and of sociology, afroamerican representations. This book is a treasure for anyone interested in photography, America and its history.

If you're interested in the mind of America, what we think and why we think it, Trachtenberg is your man. This is a very detailed, dense, and enjoyable work on the topic. Its premises are taken from

the evidence gleaned from photographs and the history of the profession, a relatively new one (in the process of its own revolution from chemical to digital).

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
