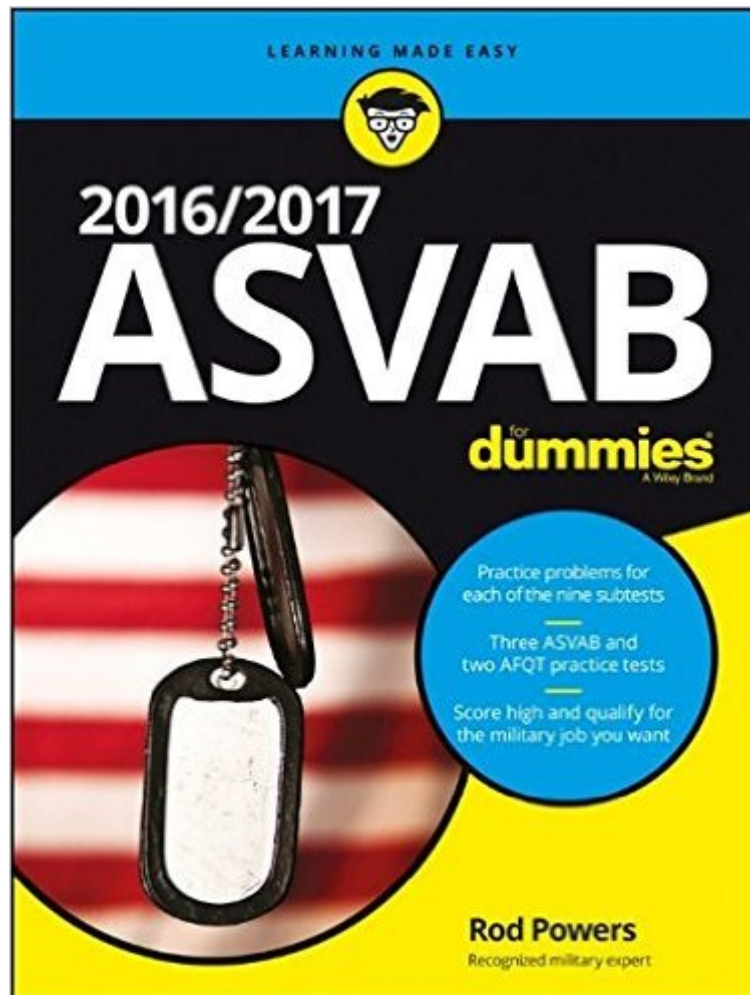

I bought this with the asvab flash cards and I'm proud to say I scored an 89 on my overall and I scored nothing lower then 78 in all 9 subjects of the asvab ! I highly recommend it if you want to have a big selection when it comes to joining the military

I got this book for my son to help him score as high as he can on the ASVAB test. It is very easy to understand and comprehend. He is already able to answer questions correctly that he couldn't before. I recommend this study guide to anyone who is wanting to increase their score on the ASVAB test. I received this product at a discounted price in exchange for my honest and unbiased opinion and review. The lack of cost did not sway my opinion or review in any way. I would have posted the same review if I had paid full price for this product.

I have two big issues with this book: First: This book spends too much time giving you really obvious test tips instead of actual practice as well as basic information about the military you either 1) already know since you are, after all, taking the steps to enroll if you bought this book, or 2) you could easily find by Googling. I would say about 20% of the book is wasted on stuff like that. This is the part that truly feels like it's "for dummies" and unfortunately not in a good or helpful way. Second: Ironically enough, while that 20% is spent on inane content, parts of the test that people might really struggle with seem bare. There are only 12 pages on auto/shop, a subject I know NOTHING about. The same number of pages applies to the electrical and mechanical sections. Yes, they're not as critical as paragraph comprehension or math/arithmetic, but if you're

trying to get an excellent score and you're not already a handyman you're going to be confused like I was. Unfortunately, for the sections that are really critical, they're also very short. I guess if you don't already know this stuff, maybe you shouldn't be enlisting, but I know a lot of people that have been out of school for a bit that are doing so, and say, only 7 pages on word comprehension, for example, just isn't going to cut it. This DOES have three practice tests, which is helpful; however, for the price you can find other study guides that have more for the same cost or a bit more. That's all I really found helpful in this guide.

Bought this for a friend who wants to enter the National Guard, but he was nervous about 3.5 hours of test taking. This book is giving him the confidence and practice to do well. He heard from a friend of a friend that this is the best ASVAB study guide out there and he's happy to have it. Already on Chapter 2!! ASVAB for Smarties, I like to call it.

Honestly could not have had a better buy. I took an ASVAB practice test roughly 2 years ago with a recruiter and scored a 60 and after deciding to join recently I bought this book brush up on basic math and such and I just took the test and scored a 94. This book honestly helped me study. I would suggest it to anyone who wants to score higher on the ASVAB.

Yeah, I'm trying to join the armed forces. Give back to society. I'm trying for the Marine Corps so its going to be a exciting process. Definitely reinforcements are needed to pursue plan and Rod Powers sure know what to bring.

There were several grammatical errors was well as answers/ explanations that didn't line up correctly. I also truly feel it didn't help me one bit on the ASVAB. I scored one point higher on the ASVAB itself after studying this whole book for about a month (leisurely) and a few days (very intensely) than I did on my practice test. I originally thought this was a good book with formulas and different sections and test questions. It was even recommended on a website. I, however, disagree completely and feel my money was wasted. I would NOT recommend this book for someone looking to find an ASVAB study guide. If anything, this book is decent for basic high school material refreshment. The charts and diagrams were pretty simple, but detailed enough to get the point across. There were also lots of practice questions and the overall book organization was easy to follow. That's really the only thing it has going for it.
